The **Acts of Settlement**, passed in 1662, and the **Act of Explanation**, passed in 1665, made provisions for confiscated lands to be administered by the Court of Claims.

The **Decrees of Innocence** issued by the Court of Claims (see above) were recorded in the Books of Survey & Distribution. These were a record of landowners (and their estates) and were used to impose the **Quit Rent**, an annual acreable rent paid on land granted under the Acts of Settlement & Explanation.
