

# References to O'Sheas, Shees etc in R.J.Hayes 'Manuscript Sources for the History of Irish Civilisation,' Persons, Boston 1965, 9 Vols.

These volumes were produced by the National Library of Ireland (NLI) under the editorship of its then director Dr R. J. Hayes, and are considered one of the most comprehensive sources for family genealogical and historical research. The volumes are available in many libraries worldwide. The extracts below include entries in a 1965 –75 supplement. Items of interest since 1975 have not yet been formally published but are catalogued by the NLI and are shown separately at the end.
