

Hearth Rolls of Co. Kilkenny

From the Irish Genealogist (1974, Vol. 5, 1 and 1975, Vol. 5, 2), extracted by Julian C. Walton from the Carrigan Manuscripts. The Hearth Tax, was introduced into Ireland in 1662. The Hearth Money Rolls are listed of all householders paying the tax, together with notes of the amount they paid.
