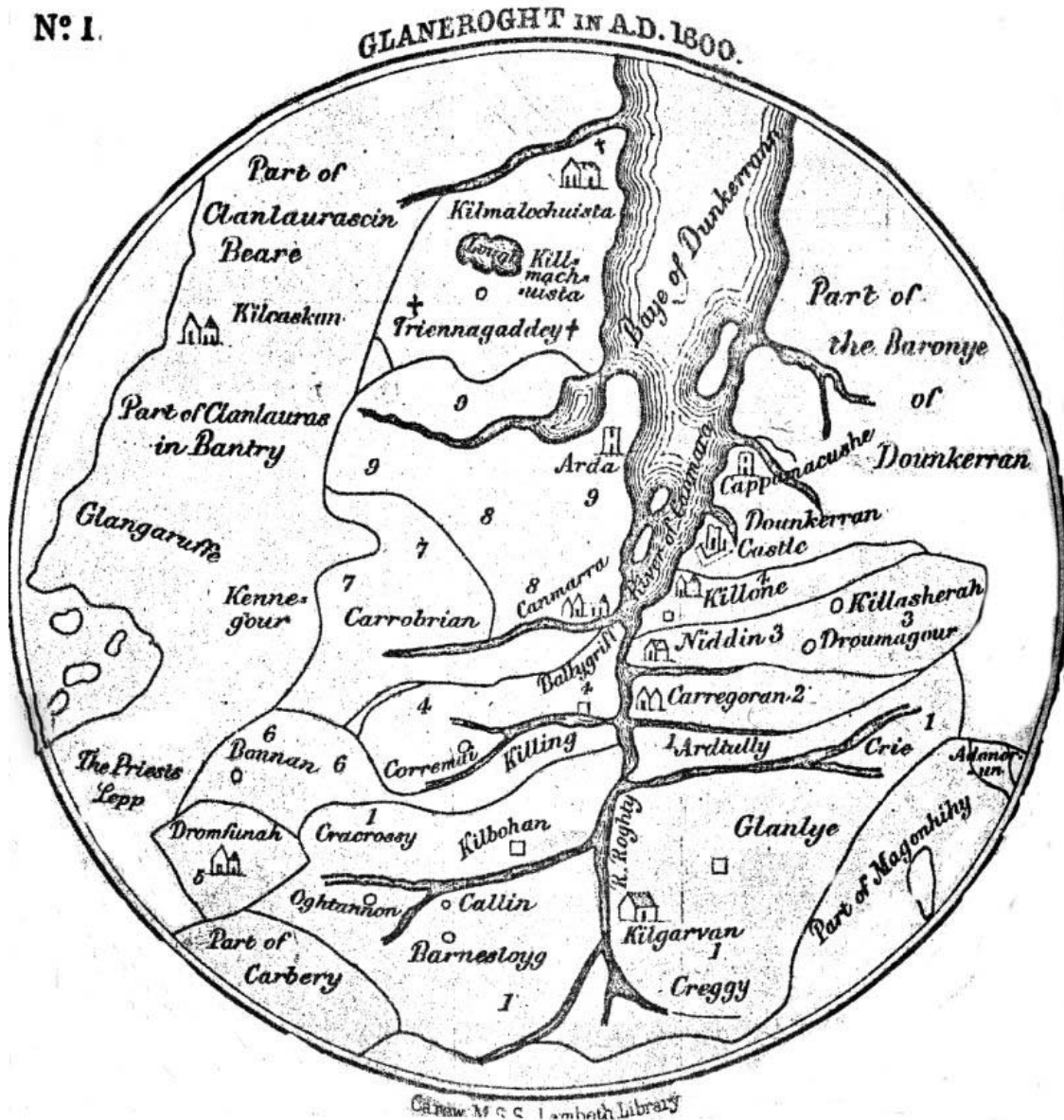


Maps of Kerry from the Carew Manuscripts (Lambeth Library)

These three maps indicate who had lands in Co. Kerry in 1600. Note that the maps are not drawn as is conventional nowadays with the north-south in the vertical. The key below each map gives the names of the freeholders of the land.

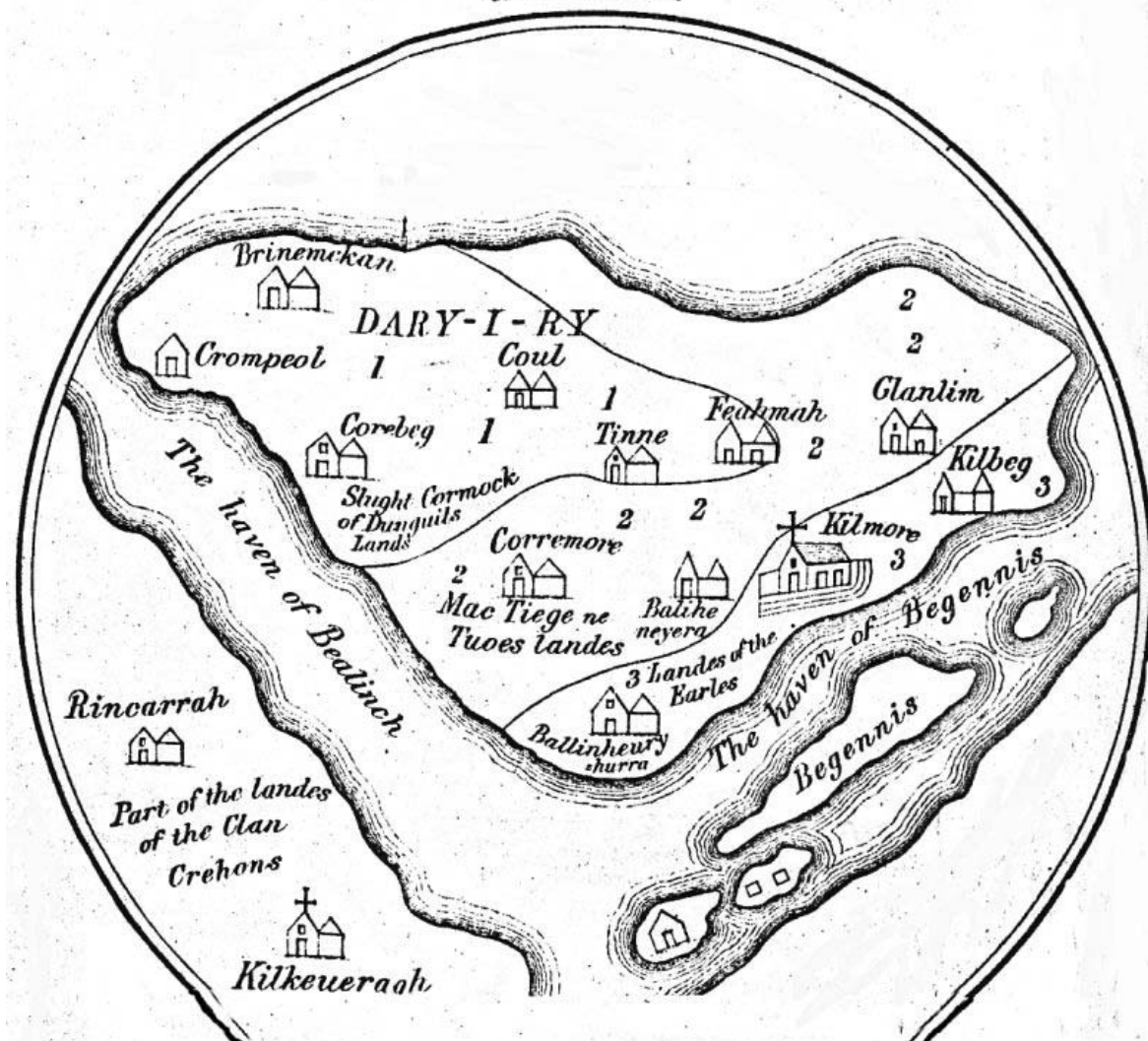
